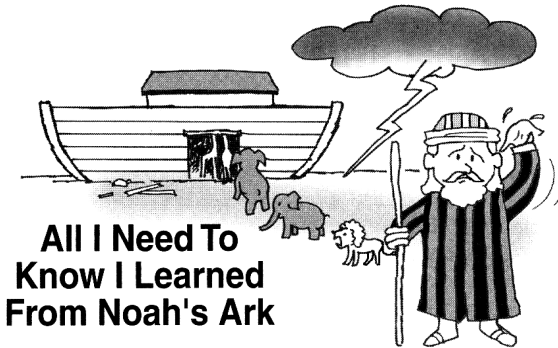
LOOKING AHEAD
